## **NCAA Eligibility Center Information & Instructions**

- ✓ **Who should register?**  
A student who plans to attend a NCAA Division I or II institution and wishes to participate in intercollegiate athletics.
  
- ✓ **How do I proceed?**  
**Junior Year**
  1. Take the SAT or ACT test. Report scores to the NCAA Eligibility Center by using code 9999; do this every time you take the test(s).**After Junior Year**
  2. Go to [www.eligibilitycenter.org](http://www.eligibilitycenter.org) and click on NCAA College-Bound Student-Athletes, create a new account and register.
  3. Please be aware that there is a processing fee of \$65 for U.S. students (\$95 for international students). You are eligible for a waiver of the registration fee only if you have already received a waiver of the SAT or ACT fee.
  4. Complete the registration. You may send a transcript to the Eligibility Center before graduation. *Make an appointment with your counselor for more information about transcripts.***During Senior Year**
  5. Continue to monitor your progress in school.
  6. Continue to update your account with the Eligibility Center.**After Graduation**
  7. An official final transcript must be sent by the school to the Eligibility Center upon graduation in order to finalize the process.
