NCAA Eligibility Center Information & Instructions

✓ Who should register?

A student who plans to attend a NCAA Division I or II institution <u>and</u> wishes to participate in intercollegiate athletics.

✓ How do I proceed?

<u>Junior Year</u>

1. Take the SAT or ACT test. Report scores to the NCAA Eligibility Center by using code 9999; do this every time you take the test(s).

After Junior Year

- 2. Go to <u>www.eligibilitycenter.org</u> and click on NCAA College-Bound Student-Athletes, create a new account and register.
- Please be aware that there is a processing fee of \$65 for U.S. students (\$95 for international students). You are eligible for <u>a</u> waiver of the registration fee only if you have already received <u>a</u> waiver of the SAT or ACT fee.
- 4. Complete the registration. You may send a transcript to the Eligibility Center before graduation. *Make an appointment with your counselor for more information about transcripts.*

<u>During Senior Year</u>

- 5. Continue to monitor your progress in school.
- 6. Continue to update your account with the Eligibility Center.
- After Graduation
- 7. An official final transcript must be sent by the school to the Eligibility Center upon graduation in order to <u>finalize the process</u>.
