1. Select the "Prints & Photographs" picture square under "Collection Highlights."
2. Scroll down and select "Civil War"

### **The Nationals Archives**

1. Select the first tab, "Research Our Records."
2. Select the bottom right box, "Browse Online Exhibits."
3. Select "Digital Vaults."
4. Click on "The National Archives Experience: The Digital Vaults" link.
5. Wait a few seconds and then click on "Continue" located on the bottom right.
6. Select the "Search" tab located at the bottom of the screen.
7. Type "Civil War" in the keyword search box found on the bottom left of the screen.

### **Destiny**

1. Go to the Ferguson homepage <http://ferguson.dadeschools.net/index>
2. Select "Information Center" located under "Students."
3. Select "Destiny" located on the left.
4. Click the "Catalog" tab.
5. Click the "Power" tab.
6. Type in "Civil War" in the first line, select the "NOT" radial button and type "fiction" on the second line, select "NOT" again and type "video" on the third line.

### **Virtual Library**

1. Go to the Ferguson homepage <http://ferguson.dadeschools.net/index>
2. Select "Information Center" located under "Students."
3. Select "Virtual Library" located on the left.
4. Select "Secondary Resources."
5. Select "Facts on File." (The username and password is "miamidade" for both without the quotation marks.)
6. Scroll down and select "American History Online."
7. Type "Civil War" on the right side. Browse through the tabs to access primary sources and/or images.
