Miami-Dade County Public Schools' Articulation Agreements

Articulation agreements are contracts between M-DCPS and postsecondary institutions which grant credit to the students at the postsecondary level for applied technology credits earned in senior high school. Articulation agreements are established for TECH Prep participating students; thereby, allowing students to progress further when they pursue their postsecondary career path. Students literally bank credits while in senior high school that they carry with them to a postsecondary institution.

The four postsecondary institutions that have current TECH Prep articulation agreements with Miami-Dade County Public Schools are:

- Ai Miami International University of Art & Design
- Florida National College
- Miami Dade College
